The Unstoppable "G.E.A.R.s" of the Gospel: Galatia, Europe, Asia, Rome

a. 1st Missionary Journey: The Gospel to <u>Galatia</u>

- Churches started in Antioch Pisidia, Iconium, Lystra, Derbe
- Galatians (ca AD 49). Theme: Going against Legalism

b. 2nd Missionary Journey: The Gospel to Europe (Macedonia & Achaia)

- Churches started in Philippi, Thessalonica, Berea, Athens, Corinth
- 1 Thessalonians (ca AD 52). Theme: Encouragement for a Thriving Church
- 2 Thessalonians (ca AD 52). Theme: Instruction on the 2nd Coming

c. 3rd Missionary Journey: The Gospel to Asia

- Churches started in Ephesus and throughout Asia Minor
- 1 Corinthians (ca AD 56). Theme: Correction for an Immature Church
- 2 Corinthians (ca AD 57). Theme: 2nd Chance for a Corrected Church
- **Romans** (*ca* 57 AD)
