Scriptures: 2 Timothy 1:4-5, Genesis 50:15-21, 32:6-7, 32:17-18, Genesis 33:1-8

1. How did this message impact you?
2. In 2 Timothy, Paul speaks specifically about the "sincere faith" of Timothy's grandmother, Lois, and his mother, Eunice. Describe what you think Lois and Eunice were like. Have you had anyone in your life that you can credit with "sincere faith"? What character values did they exhibit?
3. How did that person shape you?
4. When and from whom did Joseph learn about the power of reconciliation? Read Genesis 33:1-8. Discuss what impression the reconciliation of Jacob and Esau must have meant for the young Joseph. How can you apply this lesson to a relationship in your life now?
5. Pastor Jared said "You are reproducing in your sons and daughters your character." How does that make you feel and what do you need to do to be more aware of the power you have? What are you doing with it in your family and outside of your family?
