Sermon Questions

I Plead the Blood - Pastor Jared Herd

Scriptures: Exodus 12:21-22, 26-27, 46; John 1:29, 36; Mark 14:12-19, 22-26; John 19:14, 28-30, 32-34

1. What dots did you connect for the first time between the first Passover and Jesus on the cross? Review Exodus 12 together and discuss questions and revelations.
2. Pastor Jared discussed the elements of a Jewish Passover meal, including four cups of wine, representing God's promises to the Israelites. These four promises still apply to us today: "I will bring out, I will deliver, I will redeem and I will take." What circumstances in your life today can you connect to these promises? (Read Exodus 6:6-7 for help.)
3. Pastor Jared stated that the story of the cross is the story of a new Passover. Read Mark 14:22-26. How did approaching the new Passover table (communion) after the message feel to you? What thoughts have you had since? What "hymn" did you leave singing?
4. If the "doorway" of your life is covered with the blood (i.e. salvation), how does that change you? Does this knowledge give you peace, hope, etc.?
