4. What is one thing all the Avenger super heroes have in common?

5. Why is it important to expose our hurts to the risen Christ, the ultimate super hero?

They are less about the adventures of people who wear masks and fight crime than the hopes and dreams of people like us who want to make the world a better place. Superheroes mirror the best and the worst about us." What does he mean?
