STUDY QUESTIONS

1. What did Pastor Steve say was the truth about God that we can pluck from the Hoosiers movie scene we saw this weekend? How did this scene reveal it?

2. Take a look at Mark 4:35-41. What was the situation here?

How do you think the disciples felt about Jesus asleep in the boat? Can you relate to their reaction?

3. How did Pastor Steve describe the Sea of Galilee?

How is this body of water like life's situations?

4. Pastor Steve said that even if Jesus had stayed asleep in the boat, the disciples still would have reached His intended destination. How did he say we know this for a fact?

What do you think is *our* intended destination?

5. Pastor Steve said when we are in the midst of a hard situation we need to ask the question: “Will this storm define my faith in God or will my faith in God have victory over this storm?” Why is this question so important?

6. We learned this weekend that it’s not positive thinking that revolutionizes the way we handle life’s storms, but a different kind of thinking altogether. What was it?

Why does this make all the difference?

7. It is always fifteen feet from the free throw line to the basket and ten feet from the floor to the rim. How does this takeaway from *Hoosiers* speak to our faith in God?

MEMORIZE Isaiah 41:13 – “For I am the Lord your God who takes hold of your right hand and says to you, Do not fear; I will help you.”
